

2019 ÆRENA NORTH COAST CABERNET SAUVIGNON

INSPIRED by Theodore Roosevelt's powerful and provocative "Man in the Arena" speech, ÆRENA celebrates the humble hero in all of us who should be crowned for our best efforts every day. We partnered with artist Tony Hernandez, whose

own personality and style are the very essence

of the Man in the Ærena. Tony's a master at bringing relatable emotion to life in his characters, often depicting his everyday heroes in crowns. He works exclusively on handmade birch wood panels using the technically demanding process of encaustic painting.

ÆRENA'S "Lean in" Cabernet Sauvignon is farmed from vines at 2400 ft elevation in the Red Hills of California's North Coast. As one would expect of mountain viticulture, elevation moderates temperature extremes and diurnal shifts,

allowing for a long growing season that results in complex flavor development. The intensity of flavors is magnified by vine stress from well-drained, iron rich vineyards littered with black obsidian, quartz crystal, and volcanic gravel.

The 2019 ÆRENA Cabernet Sauvignon entices the nose with aromas of plum, cherry, warming spices, and orange zest. Flavors of cola, plum, coffee, and chocolate delight the palate leading to a fresh and youthful finish.
